5 Letters from parents with extenuating circumstances will be considered on a case by case basis for valid reasons and make-up papers.

6 If you are unable to provide any medical certificate to support the absence, your child/ward will not be awarded any marks for the review.

7 Should you have any queries on the holistic assessment items, you can clarify with your child/ward's Form Teacher. We look forward to your partnership in your child/ward's academic journey.
