We hope you had quality time bonding with your children over the school holidays. The school is excited to welcome your children back and we look forward to working closely with you in the development of your children.

## **SEMSTER 2: Key Events (September to November)**

- The school will be implementing a study break for the P6 pupils in the lead up to the PSLE written examination from Monday, 26 September to Wednesday 28 September 2022. Only pupils from the P6 level are not required to report to school during these three days.
- The P6 pupils are required to report to school for their PSLE written examination which will commence on **Thursday 29 September and end on Tuesday, 4 October 2022**.
- 4 Home-based Learning (HBL) will take place for some levels during the PSLE written examination. The **P3 and P4 levels** will be having their HBL on the following days indicated below. They **are not required** to report to school on those days.

Level	Days
Primary 3 Level	Thursday, 29 September to Friday, 30 September
Primary 4 Level	Monday, 3 October to Tuesday 4 October

- 5 Children's Day falls on **Friday, 7 October 2022**. There will be no school on that day for pupils. Children's Day will be celebrated on **Thursday, 6 October 2022** during curriculum time and pupils will be dismissed as per normal on that day.
- There will be no school for the P1 to P6 levels during the PSLE Marking Days from 17 to 20 October 2022 (Monday to Thursday). Pupils are required to return to school on Friday, 21 October 2022.
- 7 Deepavali falls on **Monday, 24 October 2022**, hence it is a scheduled public holiday.

- Pupils are not required to report to school on the Admin & Promotion Day which falls on **Friday**, **11 November 2022** and Prize Giving Day on **Friday**, **18 November 2022**. E-Learning will be administered for pupils on Admin & Promotion Day. More information will be given closer to the date.
- 9 Please make alternative care arrangement on the dates when your child/ward is not required to come to school.
- 10 With effect from 29 August 2022, it is optional for students to wear masks in all school settings, including national examinations. The school is committed to its endeavours to keep the environment safe for both staff and students. As such, the school will continue to remind staff and students to practise personal hygiene and exercise social responsibility.
- The year-end school vacation will commence from **Saturday**, **19 November**. Pupils will return to school for the new academic year for 2023 on **Tuesday**, **3 January 2023**.
