Primary 3 SwimSafer 2.0 Programme Assessment

2 In order to receive a stage certification, each pupil is required to pass a **practical assessment and an online theory quiz**. Pupils will need to pass the online theory quiz administered through the ActiveSG portal within 2 months from the completion of the practical assessment.

3 Please note that there will be **no make-up session** for the practical assessment if your child fails to turn up on the stated practical assessment date. The details of the practical assessment are as follows:

5 In a national effort to reduce the use of paper, electronic certificates (e-Certs) will be issued to participants who have passed the practical assessment and online theory quiz of the SwimSafer 2.0 Programme. The e-Certs will be made available in the ActiveSG account of the participants.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS – SwimSafer 2.0 Programme

1. Why is there an online theory quiz for SwimSafer 2.0?

As part of consolidating the learning of water safety knowledge in the PE curriculum through the SwimSafer 2.0 programme, pupils will need to pass an online theory quiz administered through ActiveSG portal within 2 months from the completion of practical assessment.

The online theory quiz may be taken from the time the pupils are registered for the programme by pupils at their own time, or during a centralized time organized by the school. A pupil is considered to have passed a stage of the SwimSafer 2.0 programme only if he/she passes BOTH the practical assessment and theory online quiz.

2. How do the pupils take their online theory quiz?

- Pupils have to log onto the ActiveSG Portal
- Input Assessment Code, BC/NRIC, Date of Birth (DOB)
- Click LOGIN
- Click Start theory quiz to begin
(Pupils are allowed multiple attempts by the last date to pass the quiz)
- Click Submit to complete the quiz

3. What happens to pupils who fail their practical assessment in the SwimSafer 2.0 Programme?

Parents are encouraged to support their children's continual learning by signing up for external swimming lessons and/or re-test at their own time.
